*Read the following text : **The 4-Day Workweek: Productivity Over Hours***

The concept of a 4-day workweek is gaining popularity in many countries. Companies that have adopted it report increased productivity, higher employee satisfaction, and reduced burnout. The idea challenges the traditional belief that longer hours mean better results.

Critics argue that a shorter week might not be suitable for all industries, especial those that rely on constant customer service. However, supporters emphasize that with clear goals and better time management, employees can achieve the same—if not better—outcomes in fewer hours.

In 2022, a major UK trial involved over 60 companies testing the 4-day week. Most of them found no drop in performance, and many chose to make the change permanent. As work culture continues to evolve, the focus seems to be shifting from time spent to results delivered.
